To be eligible for the Illinois Retired Law Enforcement License Plates, an applicant must certify that he or she is a
retired law enforcement officer as defined below.

720 ILCS 5/2-13

Sec. 2-13. "Peace officer" "Peace officer" means (i) any person who by virtue of his office or public employment is
vested by law with a duty to maintain public order or to make arrests for offenses, whether that duty extends to all
offenses or is limited to specific offenses, or (ii) any person who, by statute, is granted and authorized to exercise powers
similar to those conferred upon any peace officer employed by a law enforcement agency of this State.

Also included are federal law enforcement officer as defined in 745 ILCS 22/5, including but not limited to the United
States Department of Justice, The Federal Bureau of Investigation, The Drug Enforcement Agency and The Department
of Immigration and Naturalization, The United States Department of the Treasury, The Secret Service, The Bureau of
Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms and The Customs Service, The United States Internal Revenue Service, The United
States General Services Administration, The United States Postal Service and United States Marshals or Deputy United
States Marshals.

The application and this affirmation must be sent to the Illinois Sheriffs Association, 401 E Washington Springfield, IL
62701 for review and approval before license plates can be issued. Please complete the following below,
